

END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA) – SAFE SUITE TRIAL VERSION v1.0

IMPORTANT – READ CAREFULLY

This End User License Agreement (“Agreement”) is a legal agreement between you (“Licensee”) and Cynoss S.L., the owner and licensor of the software product SafeSuite, a requirements management system. By installing, copying, or otherwise using the trial version of SafeSuite (“Software”), you agree to be bound by the terms of this Agreement. If you do not agree to the terms of this Agreement, do not install or use the Software.

This Agreement covers the TRIAL use of the following Suite modules.

SafeSuite, requirements Manager.

SafeFIT, MTBF and FIT calculator software.

SafeFMEA, FMEA, FMDEA, FMECA Software.

SafeTree, Fault Tree Analyzer Software.

1. Grant of License

Cynoss S.L. grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited license to use the TRIAL version of SafeSuite solely for the purpose of evaluation for a limited period of time, as defined by Cynoss.

2. Trial Period

The Trial version is made available free of charge for a limited time period (the “Trial Period”), the duration of which will be communicated upon delivery or installation. During this Trial Period, the Software may have limited functionality.

3. No Obligation to Purchase

Use of the Trial version of the Software does not create any obligation or commitment to purchase, subscribe, or enter into any commercial agreement for the full version. No financial commitment or contractual obligation arises from the installation or use of the Trial version.

4. Restrictions

You may not:

- Reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software;
- Use the Software for production, commercial, or competitive analysis purposes;
- Sell, rent, lease, or sublicense the Software;
- Circumvent any restrictions or limitations built into the Trial version.

5. Ownership

The Software is licensed, not sold. Cynoss retains all rights, title, and interest in and to the Software and all associated intellectual property rights.

6. No Warranty

The Trial version is provided "AS IS" without warranty of any kind. Cynoss disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, and non-infringement.

7. Limitation of Liability

In no event shall Cynoss be liable for any damages arising out of or in connection with the use or inability to use the Trial version, including but not limited to loss of data, loss of business, or indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages.

8. Termination

This Agreement will terminate automatically at the end of the Trial Period unless extended in writing by Cynoss or converted to a commercial license. Cynoss may also terminate this Agreement at any time without notice if you breach any terms.

9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Spain. Any dispute arising from or in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Madrid, Spain.

10. Transition to Commercial Use

Should you decide to continue using SafeSuite after the Trial Period, a separate license agreement and payment terms must be executed. Until such agreement is in place, no rights beyond this Trial license are granted.

By installing or using the Trial version of SafeSuite, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Agreement and agree to be bound by its terms.
